The Nordic Society for Clinical Microbiology and Infectious Diseases gathers clinicians and researchers in clinical microbiology and infectious diseases annually for a 4-day meeting which is usually held in early autumn. All Nordic countries take turns hosting the annual meeting.

Lectures and discussions in the meeting focus on Nordic clinical reality, health care structure and scientific and technological advances that are of common interest to all of us working in infectious diseases, clinical microbiology, biomedical science and infection prevention and control. The meeting provides important networking opportunities and is without parallel sessions, making fruitful discussions between the specialties possible. The official meeting language is English. NSCMID works closely with the national societies

The NSCMID board consists of two specialists from each of the five Nordic countries, one from infectious diseases and one from clinical microbiology. One county representative is selected by the national societies and the other by the members of NSCMID. The Society has several working groups that network Nordic experts in practical issues and research. New working groups are supported by NSCMID.

NSCMID calls for proposals for sessions in the Annual Meeting, webinars and other activities which can be discussed with the national board members.
